How are you? Teachers and administrators and counselors miss their students! Please let us know how you are doing, and make sure you connect with us in the next while. While most teachers are working from home, we are prepared to begin the online learning process with you after Spring Break. We know that together we will be successful in supporting your learning even though this will be a new experience for all of us.

Learning materials for you will be released slowly as we all adjust to a new delivery of instruction. This is the schedule that all high school students across Edmonton will follow:

Monday, March 30, 2020 Period 1 only Day 1 students 9 am Day 2 students 1 pm

Tuesday, March 31, 2020 Period 2 only Day 1 students 9 am Day 2 students 1 pm

Wednesday, April 1, 2020 Period 3 only Day 1 students 9 am Day 2 students 1 pm

Thursday, April 2, 2020 Period 4 only Day 1 students 9 am Day 2 students 1 pm

Friday, April 3, 2020 Periods 0 and 5 only Day 1 students 9 am Day 2 students 1 pm

This means that you will receive only one period of educational materials per day for the first week and probably for the second week, too. We will start off slow to ensure you are not overwhelmed with this new delivery system and that you can connect with your teachers. You are important as a partner in this new venture, and we will learn together.

I know that most of you do not have access to your notes or textbooks, so we will not rely on them as we start learning together again. We will focus on the Essential Learning Outcomes from the Program of Studies and we will share support materials with you. Much of this will happen through SchoolZone and Google Classroom, but we will have a variety

of ways to share material with you. Please let your friends know that if they do not have access to technology they can contact us at the school 780-408-9800 and we will help. We can also make print material if that is what works for a specific student...we are here to help you learn and we will adapt to what works for you.

Right now, it is essential that you are healthy and that your family is safe. Spring Break can be a wonderful time to continue learning in various ways.
